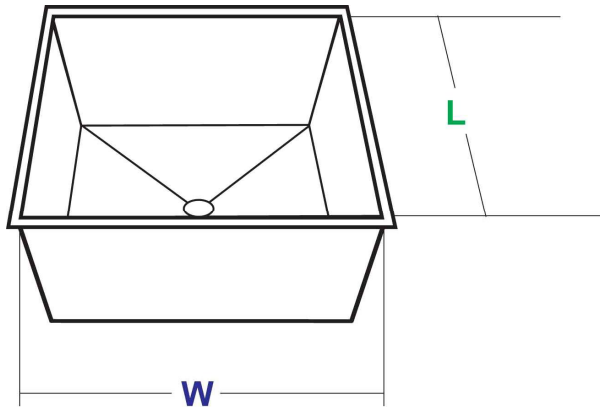


GALLONS PER INCH CALCULATION FOR SINKS

3 gal.	=	693
4 gal.	=	924
7.5 gal.	=	1,732.5
8 gal.	=	1,848
10 gal.	=	2,310
16 gal.	=	3,696
20 gal.	=	4,620

Calculate area “A” of sink bottom by multiplying W x L:
