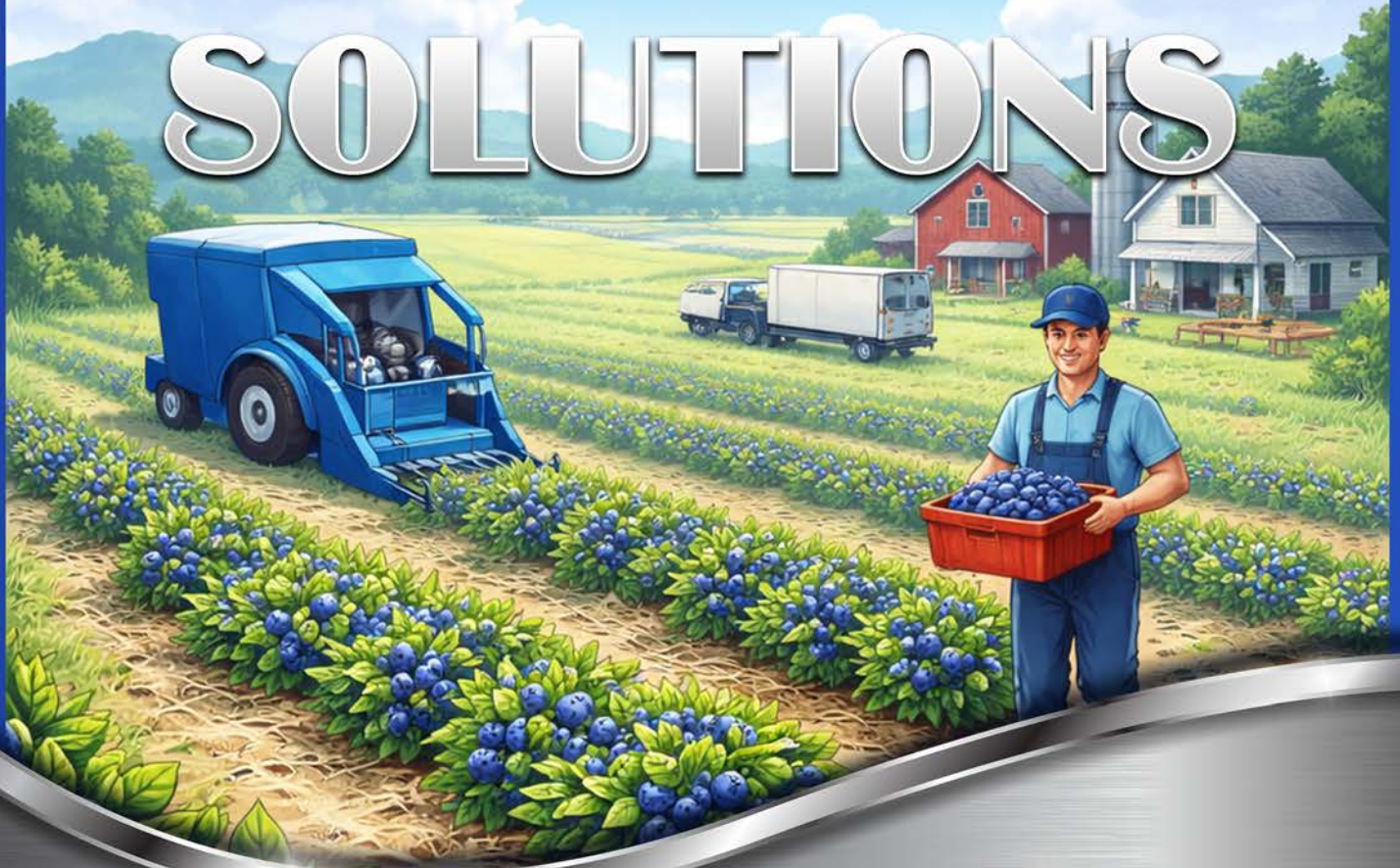

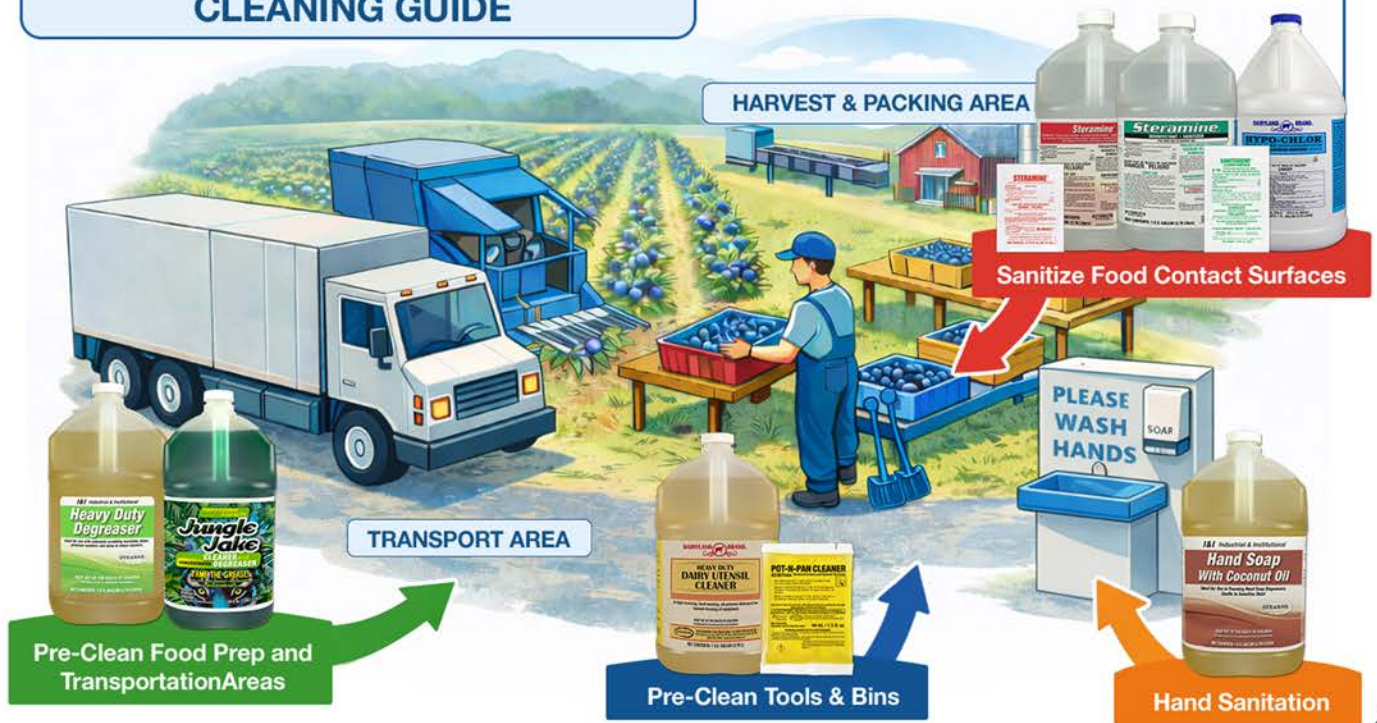

Food Contact Surface Sanitizers

- Non-foaming formula, no rinse required
- Ideal for sanitizing food contact zones

- For bins, tables, counters, trays, and packing equipment
- Effective on hard, non-porous surfaces
- Dilute per label, allow contact time, **air dry – no rinse**
